This document lists the issues addressed by this release. All known issues published under previous release notes still apply until listed as “Fixed Issues”.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

General

- Microsoft Internet Explorer 8 is not a supported browser. The browsers officially supported for use with Summation Pro are Internet Explorer 9 or higher.

5.6.3 PATCH 2 FIXED ISSUES

The following issues have been resolved in this patch:

General

- Environments upgraded from version 3.3 will no longer receive IASDomainService errors. (28383)
- “Remove From Case Organizer” operations are now visible in the Project Work List. (28540)

Viewer

- The Viewer will now show branding on TIFF images produced from multipage TIFF or PDF source images. (28011)
- Viewer performance and browser memory utilization improved for large files (e.g., 100MB PDF). (29218)
- Emails in an MHT format now display correctly in the Viewer. (29348)
- Certain PDFs no longer appear upside down when viewed in the Standard Viewer. (29611)

Search

- Better handling of special characters with DTSearch and when merge indexing. (29187/29442)
- Improved user interface performance to eliminate “hangs” during long-running searches. (29461)
- Modifications made to Quick Search and Advanced Search. (29463)
- Search hit highlights display correctly in viewers that have been “popped out” into a separate browser window. (29503)

Imaging

- Bates numbers within a document increment correctly when branding in a bulk-imaging job. (29508)
- Bates numbers across multiple documents increment correctly when branding in a bulk-imaging job. (29516)

Production

- Redactions made to rotated documents appear correctly in production images. (28217, 29586)
- Redactions made to imported images are applied correctly to production images. (28912)
- The Labels pulldown in the Production Set and Export Set creation windows will now populate in projects with large numbers of labels and labeled records. (28755)
- PDF production images no longer fail to generate (i.e., receive a slipsheet) on records where redactions are made to the record’s image and the record has had both a native SWF and an image SWF generated. (29504)
- Export or production of PST-based emails or attachments using either the “Original Filename” option or the “Original Filename and Path” option succeeds even if there are illegal values in the path. (29097, 29339)

Collection (eDiscovery)

- Network collections succeed when collecting from shares that share the same trailing 10 characters in their names. (26658)
